WHAT FRUIT AND VEGETABLES ARE IN GOOD SUPPLY?

The SDFP team keep a constant eye on what is performing the best. Here is the fruit and vegetable lines that are in good supply:

VEGETABLES

ASPARAGUS, BEANS, BABY FENNEL, BROCCOLI, CAULIFLOWER, LETTUCE COS, LETTUCE ICEBERG, KALE, CELERIAC AND EGGPLANT.

FRUIT

BLACKBERRIES, PEACHES/NECTARINES, MANGOES, ROCKMELON, HONEYDEW AND LIMES.

Petite Bouche is a specialist producer of high end herbs, baby vegetables, edible flowers and micro herbs. Here is what's hot and not:

GOOD SUPPLY

GREEN ELK, CONFETTI CORIANDER, RED VEIN SORREL, SALAD BURNET, BLACK MINT, BABY TURNIPS, MICRO SAGE AND FINGER FENNEL.

LIMITED SUPPLY

BABY CORN, BULLS BLOOD (FINISHED), AMSTERDAM CARROTS AND EDIBLE FLOWERS.

WHATS IN SHORT SUPPLY AND COMING TO END OF ITS SEASON?

All good produce comes to the end of it's season, get's affected by weather or has a rise in price due to shortages and high demand. Here is an overlook for YOU:

SHORT SUPPLY AND HIGH PRICE

GREEN SWEET POTATO, FIGS, LEMONS, GRAPES, PINEAPPLES AND ALL POTATO LINES.

ALL POTATO LINES including Sweet Potato remain extremely short in supply and are reaching record prices, anywhere from \$3 - \$4 per kg. We expect this to last another 3 - 4 weeks until new season South Australian crops kick in properly.

BROAD BEANS are still plentiful but hard to find good eating ones.

FINISHING FOR THE SEASON

KUMQUATS, RAPPE, NETTLES, BLOOD ORANGES AND BABY ARTICHOKES.
